Shape: Triangle

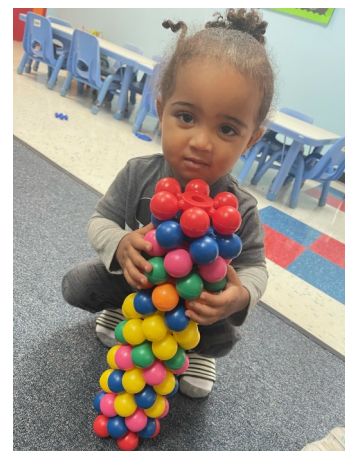



Here are just a few reminders for the two's class:

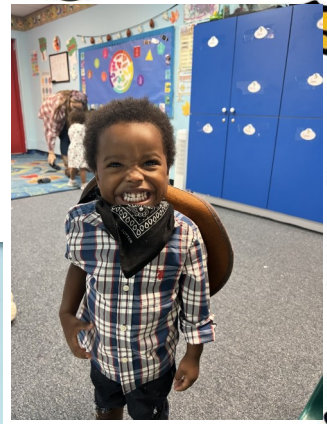
In this class, we heavily focus on POTTY TRAINING! Please send lots of extra clothes if your child is just beginning the process. There will be accidents!
