- If your child is doing well with potty training and they are in underwear, keep them that way please. If they are put back in pull ups they will get confused, which can make the process more difficult.

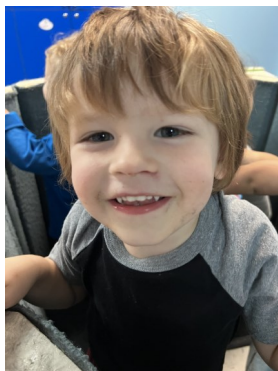
Please leave pacifiers at home! As per our handbook, pacifiers are not supposed to go past the one year old room.
