Color: Black

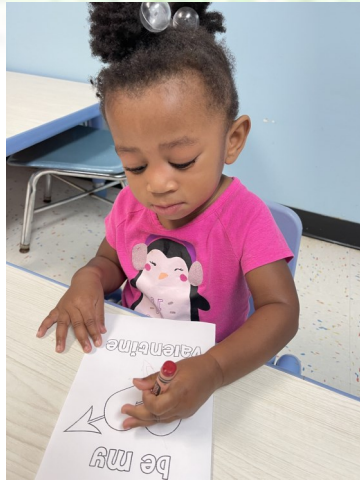

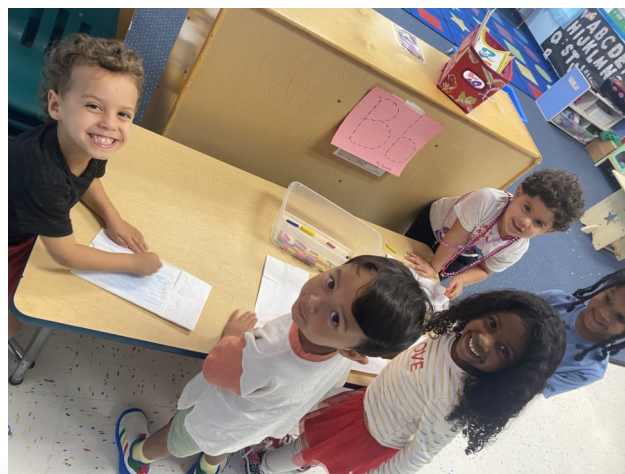
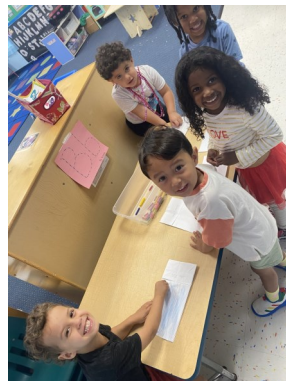
Welcome March
