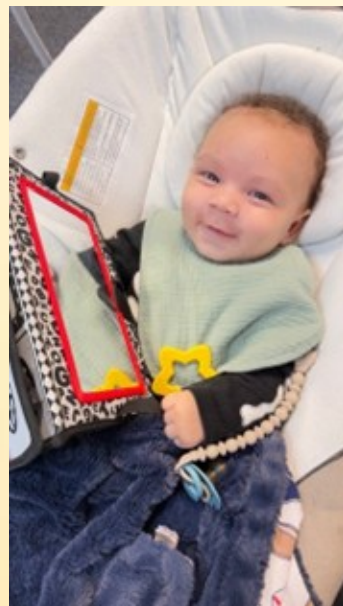
In our circle time we will be focusing on: Letter: P, N, and C. Number: 5. Color: Yellow. Shape: Triangle.

 - Throwing up
 - Diarrhea 3 or more times
 - Severe coughing/cold symptoms
- Any other unusual signs or symptoms of illness

-If your child has a fever in the morning, please do not give them medicine and bring them in, they are still contagious.

-If your child has a fever the night before school, please keep them home, (we have a 24 hour policy)

-If your child is throwing up the night before or in the morning, please keep them home.

-If your child has had diarrhea 3 or more times within a day, please keep them home.
